POLICY BCBA COUNCIL OFFICERS POWERS OF CHAIR

The South Slave Divisional Education Council acknowledges that on rare occasions immediate action may be required and the Chairperson of the South Slave Divisional Education Council is hereby authorized to act in accordance with the best established practice subject to ratification by the Council at the earliest opportunity and no later than the next regular meeting.

REGULATIONS

When immediate action is required, the Chairperson shall use as a guide the following criteria:

- a) the decision is in keeping with the Council's educational philosophy;
- b) the decision meets the legal requirements of a given situation;
- c) the decision is in keeping with the Education Act;
- d) the decision appears to be the most appropriate for the Division.
