- *Partners in Education* - includes support staff (eg. Secretaries and custodians) parents, students, volunteers and other community members/groups that work in support of student learning

The Award Selection Committee will look for specific examples of how the nominee’s teaching or leadership positively contributed to school improvement and/or student success. Each award recipient will receive an award certificate and commemorative plaque. *The deadline for nominations for the 2005-06 Award is March 31st, 2006.*
